CHECK-IN - July 27 - 9:00 AM DEPARTURE 9:30am

Check-in will be in the main lobby Entrance A

Students will drop off items they do not need for the bus ride, near the trailer on the median. (ex. suitcases, sleeping bags, etc.)

Once students have checked-in and have placed items on the curb to be loaded in the trailer, they will need to stay in the lobby area until told to load bus/vans

Students may bring snacks for the ride and money for offering and snack shack

Pushpay If you are looking for a quick way to make payments towards events and tithing places. events and tithing, please consider Pushpay. This is a great and easy tool to manage your payments to Oakhill Baptist Church.

Just download the app and answer the questions to create your account. If you are paying for an event remember to include the event name and students name on the memo line.

All payments can be made directly to the church or through Pushpay. Fill out the missions and events envelope (be sure to include Kids camp and students name) and place in the offering plate, or grey box beside the welcome desk or outside the main office.

HOUSEKEEPING

<u>COPY OF MEDICAL CARD</u> - Please submit a copy of your child's medical card prior to camp departure. (Place it in April Sharp's mailbox located in the supply room next to the church office)

<u>MEDICATION</u> - If your child takes medication, please have their medication in the prescription filled bottle and placed in a zip lock baggie with their name on it and instructions for the leaders in the baggie. You will also be asked to fill out a form at the time of check-In.

<u>DRESS CODE</u> - Please review the attached dress code from Crossings to be sure that your student packs appropriate clothing.

If your child is participating in Messy games - please Include swim goggles and clothes that can be thrown away If gotten too messy.

If you child is participating in zipline of climbing please Include proper shorts (thick khakis or jean shorts)

<u>IPODS AND OTHER ELECTRONICS</u> - The bus ride to and from camp will only be a few hours, so we are asking students to please not bring any electronic devices. The camp has a strict policy of no ipods/mp3 players or cell phones, so students will be unable to use them once we arrive at camp anyway.

<u>CELL PHONE</u> - Your child's cell phone will be their responsibility. There is not good reception at the camp so I would encourage them to keep it in their bag during camp or not bring it at all. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, you may contact your student by calling April Sharp 812-568-1144.
